

Wisdom's Absinthe Selection:

Absinthe Verte

St. George has hand-crafted a spirit whose grace and balance define the pinnacle of the distiller's art form. We started with fine brandy, then carefully blended wormwood, anise and fennel, and finished with lemon balm, hyssop, stinging nettles, meadowsweet, tarragon, basil and mint. The result is delicate, layered and fresh. *This is the American absinthe that the French are trying to import—a true credit to its quality.*

Lucid Absinthe Superior

Lucid is formulated by world renowned absinthe expert T.A. Breaux, and is distilled in strict accordance to traditional French methods. Lucid is crafted in the historic Combier distillery, founded in 1834 and designed by Gustave Eiffel in the fabled Loire Valley of France. Each bottle of lucid is carefully prepared by skilled craftsmen, using ancient copper absinthe alembics. It is distilled entirely from spirits and European herbs, and uses no artificial additives, oils, or dyes.

Pernod

In 1805, Henri-Louis Pernod founded the first absinthe distillery. During the 19th century, Pernod Absinthe became the source of inspiration to many painters & poets & enjoyed immense popularity both in France and Europe. Today's Pernod is based on the original recipe.

Kübler

Launched in 1863 by J. Fritz Kübler in Motiers, Switzerland. Motiers is the capital of the Val-de-Travers, the birthplace of Absinthe. Its unique microclimate is a key factor in the quality of the ingredients that are grown in the region and used in the production of Kübler Absinthe.

Kübler uses a grain neutral base of Swiss wheat and also includes Hyssop, Lemon Balm, Coriander, Star Anise, Fennel, Artemisia Pontica and Mint according to its original formula. Each of these ingredients is grown locally in the Val-de-Travers.

LE TOURMENT VERT (The Green Torment)

Le Torment is crafted at Distillerie Vinet Ege, located near Cognac City in France. Distillerie Vinet Ege is a small family owned artisanal distillery in operation since 1934. It specializes in high quality, handcrafted limited quantity products including fine cognacs such as Remy Martin XO. Le Tourment Vert contains the maximum dosage of thujone currently allowed by the United States Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB). TTB has given provisional approval to Le Tourment Vert, and a limited quantity has recently cleared US Customs.
